

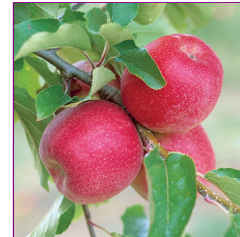

'Rosy Glow' - Apple

- Origin:** A. G. and H. C. Mason, Forest Range, South Australia.
- Fruit size :** Medium for season.
- Shape:** Round-oblong.
- Skin:** A very attractive deep pink to reddish-pink over a pale yellow ground colour. Has the ability to colour in shaded parts of the tree canopy and in areas where colour can be difficult to obtain. For superior fruit colour overuse of nitrogen is not recommended. Susceptible to bruising and skin damage if poorly handled.
- Flesh:** Creamy-white. Juicy. Firm.
- Flavour:** Good, sprightly.
- Blossom:** Mid-season.
- Pollination:** Possibly 'Granny Smith', 'Gala', 'Fuji' or any diploid cultivar which blossoms simultaneously, except Pink Lady™.
- Cropping:** Precocious, regular. Usually minimal thinning required.
- Tree habit:** Vigorous, upright, standard type.
- Maturity:** Estimated +54 days 'Red Delicious'.
- Comments:** Distinctive appearance, sprightly flavour. This cultivar has high fruit colour enabling the grower to harvest fruit at optimum maturity for C.A. storage. The advantage of 'Rosy Glow' over the conventional Pink Lady™ is increased skin colour while the fruit is still firm and at a stage where it will store.
